## Massively distributed BIG DATA management for Enterprises

More and more companies recognize the value of digitalized information and data for their business. We see a clear trend that business models are adapted or completely changed by putting data into the center of their operations. Managing these data from infrastructure, data ingestion, data consistency, data manipulation to data consumption becomes therefore even more critical especially when considering the huge amount of data, which are created in enterprises (BIG DATA).
