It is our pleasure to present you the proceedings of ICTERI 2019 PhD Symposium being held in conjunction with ICTERI 2019, the Fifteenth International Conference on Information and Communication Technologies in Education, Research, and Industrial Applications: Integration, Harmonization, and Knowledge Transfer. The conference and symposium take place in Kherson (Ukraine) on June 12 - 15, 2019.

This volume thematically follows the scope of ICTERI and is focused on research advances, information systems technologies and applications, business/academic applications of Information and Communication Technologies, the role of ICT in Education.
